ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS DUES OVERVIEW

Second invoices notices were mailed on February2nd. The following information was included on 2015 Annual Assessment Statement A 90-day payment plan is available upon written request to qualifying homeowners. "Individual Assessment payment plan" request form is required, and will include in the individual's personal files. The costs associated with the collection process are owed by the homeowner. Delinquent accounts will be turned over to the attorney. We strongly encourage all homeowners to avoid this process by making payment or making arrangements.

There's a new towing policy in place and will be enforced at the owners expense. We encourage homeowners and renters to park in their garages to minimize double parking on the street. By no means should you block your neighbor's walkway.

No boats or trailers or RV, campers, etc parked on streets No dogs outside fence areas without leash Heavy trash pick-up day is Wednesday should be placed out front Tuesday night or Wednesday morning. No trash should be visible at any other times of the week.

A home owned found in violation will receive a violation notice.
